11<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL EDUCATORS' COOPERATIVE SUMMIT AND ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PHILIPPINE FEDERATION OF TEACHERS AND EMPLOYEES COOPERATIVES (PFTEC)

- 1. The Philippine Federation of Teachers and Employees' Cooperatives (PFTEC), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepED) and the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), will conduct the 11th National Educators' Cooperative Summit (NECS) on May 22-23, 2009, to be followed by its Annual General Assembly (AGA) on May 24, 2009 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The theme of the summit and general assembly is "Building Member-Relations: Key to Unity and Solidarity of Teachers' Cooperatives".
- 3. PFTEC member-owners in the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) shall be the hosts of this event, with the Employees Welfare and Benefits Division (EWBD), DepED Central Office, providing the necessary assistance and technical support.
- 4. The purpose of the summit and general assembly is to bring together the cooperative leaders and officials of the education sector in developing resilient plans under the global economic recession in the pursuit of quality education and teachers' welfare and benefits through cooperatives. Specifically, this year's summit aims to:

a. increase awareness on the progress of previous Educators Cooperative Summits;

b. serve as a forum for the exchange of ideas on how the teachers' cooperatives can develop partnership vis-a-vis resilient strategic development plans and programs under the global economic recession;

c. develop an understanding on the importance of focusing on member-care orientation and member-care service standards;

d. formulate strategies in member loyalty towards members satisfaction; and

e. share successful experiences in public relations and marketing strategy in the cooperative.

- Participants to this live-in summit and general assembly are board of directors, officers and managers of DepED teachers' and employees' cooperatives who shall attend on official time only. Their registration fees, traveling expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged to their respective cooperative education funds. School administrators, school superintendents, regional directors and other officials of DepED shall attend on official business.
- A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) shall be charged 6. each participant. PFTEC members may avail of the discounted registration fees in the amount of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) if paid not later than April 25, 2009. The registration fees shall cover expenses for the following:
  - Two (2) days full board (meals to start with afternoon snacks on May 22, 2009 up to breakfast on May 24, 2009);
  - Conference materials/handouts; souvenir program; and
  - Eco-Education tour opportunity on May 23, 2009.
- Expenses to be incurred by the EWBD staff and other personnel of the DepED Central Office shall be charged against the appropriation for the formation of teachers' cooperatives included in the DepED budget for CY 2009.
