67TH COMMEMORATION OF THE ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK

- 1. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 203, s. 1987, declaring April 9 of every year as the Araw Ng Kagitingan and the Presidential Proclamation No. 466, s. 1989 declaring the period of April 5-11 of every year as the Philippine Veterans Week, all government agencies including government-owned and controlled corporations, non-government organizations, private associations and institutions, and individuals are enjoined to assist, cooperate, and participate in this historic commemoration. The theme of this year's celebration is "Beteranong Pilipino: Kabalikat Sa Pagsulong Ng Matatag na Republika".
- 2. The commemoration aims to promote, preserve, and memorialize the principles, ideals and deeds of the war veterans as a means to enhance patriotism and love of country, especially among the youth.
- 3. This Department, being a member of the Multi Agency Task Force (MATF) encourages all DepED regional, division, and school officials to hold a Panayam and Talakayan and other meaningful and fitting activities with the participation of students in both public and private schools.
- 4. A Panayam at Talakayan will be conducted for the 15 Divisions of DepED National Capital Region (NCR) in the morning of April 2, 2009, Thursday at DepED-Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City to be followed by the Paligsahan sa Pagsulat ng Sanaysay (Essay Writing) in the afternoon to be participated in by the high school students of the said region (1 delegate per division).
- 5. As one of the highlights of the said commemoration, this Department in coordination with the Department of National Defense (DND) will conduct the First National Creative Painting Competition on April 4, 2009, Saturday at DepED-Bulwagan ng Karunungan.

GENERAL GUIDELINES Rules and Regulations

- 1. The Essay Writing shall be choose from among the students who attended the Panayam at Talakayan in the morning of April 3, 2009 at the DepED-Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
- 2. Each division (NCR only will be represented with one representative who is presently enrolled in the public or private Secondary schools in Metro Manila.
- 3. The contestant should express his/her ideas and feelings on the theme: "Beteranong Pilipino: Kabalikat Sa Pagsulong Ng Matatag Na Republika"
- 4. The organizers will provide materials for the contestants.
- 5. All the entries must be written in Filipino with the maximum of 1,500 words and a minimum 1,200 words.
- 6. The criteria for judging include:

Substance and Originality - 50%
Style and Language - 30%
Organization - 20%
100%

- 7. The organizers have the right (DND and DepED to publish the winning entries.
- 8. The contest shall be manage by the DepED- Special Events Unit and sponsored by the Department of National Defense (DND), the lead agency of the celebration. Expenses incurred during the conduct of the contest such as prizes, honoraria of the judges, and facilitators shall be charged to the DND Araw ng Kagitingan funds while the food during the Panayam and Talakayan and the Essay Writing Contest shall be charge to DepED funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
- 9. The prizes are:

 1st Prize
 P5,000.00

 2nd Prize
 P4,000.00

 3rd Prize
 P3,000.00

10. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

Araw Ng Kagitingan And Philippine Veterans Week Creative Painting Contest

GENERAL GUIDELINESRules and Regulations

- 1. The Creative Painting Competition shall be open to all high school students nationwide. Each Region is entitled to one (1) entry to the national level competition.
- 2. The theme of the competition is: "Beteranong Pilipino: Kabalikat Sa Pagsulong at Matatag Na Republika"
 - a. It should be in a poster type and should have a poetic caption in two, three, or four lines, free verse or with rhyme and meter, typewritten at the back of the painting (Filipino or English);
 - b. The painting should be done on a illustration board to be given by the managing committee.
 - c. The contestant can use any medium or coloring materials.
- 3. The criteria for judging include:

b.	Visual Impact 30%	
a.	Originality	40%

- 4. The competition aims to increase awareness of the significance of the Araw Ng Kagitingan, as a shinning moment of courage and commitment to freedom by our World War II Veterans.
- 5. The contest shall be managed by DepED-Special Events Unit and sponsored by the Department of National Defense (DND), the lead agency of the celebration. Expenses incurred during the conduct of the contest such as prizes, honoraria of the judges, and facilitators shall be charged to the DND Araw Ng Kagitingan funds while the food during the contest shall be charge to DepED funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. The contestants with their advisers will bring their painting paraphernalia except the illustration board of which it will be given by the managing committee.
- 7. The prizes are:

1st Prize - P20,000.00+trophy & certificate for the coach/school

2nd Prize - P15,000.00+trophy & certificate for the coach/school

3rd Prize - P10,000.00+trophy & certificate for the coach/school

- 8. The DND and DepED have the right to publish the entries and has the right to own the paintings.
- 9. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
