**2009 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education (DepED), in coordination with the Philippine Normal University (PNU), the Cebu Normal University (CNU) and the University of Southeastern Philippines (USEP), Davao City, will conduct the Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired (STPT) and the Multiple Disability and Visual Impairment (MDVI) Training for Teachers. These programs aim to enhance competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with visual impairment in regular schools. These are sponsored by the Resources for the Blind, Inc., Christoffel Blindenmission, Dark and Light Foundation and the Hildeshimer Foundation. The trainings will be held on the following dates and venues:

Luzon Area	:	Philippine Normal University (PNU) Taft Avenue, Manila STPT - April 13 to May 8, 2009 MDVI - May 11-22, 2009
Visayas Area	:	Cebu Normal University (CNU) Cebu City STPT - April 13 to May 8, 2009 MDVI - May 11-22, 2009
Mindanao Area	:	University of Southeastern Philippines (USEP) Davao City STPT - April 13 to May 8, 2009 MDVI - May 11-22, 2009

2. Participants/nominees in the three (3) areas shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the visually impaired (Enclosure No. 1). The nominees shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2. All successful nominees should sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) in Enclosure No. 3 before the start of the Training Program. Deadline for submission of nominees is on March 20, 2009. (032) 232-2004 for CNU (Visayas) and to

Ms. Amy Mojica or Ms. Jasmin Batao at tel. no. (082) 225-8937 to 38 for USEP (Mindanao). The RISC shall submit the final list of nominees and the required documents to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before March 29, 2009.

3. Selected teachers who are recipients of the DepED-RBI Summer Training Programs in 2007 and 2008 will be informed of their continuation (Enclosure No. 4). Only those teachers who are actually providing services to the visually impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue their training this summer 2009.

4. All grantees shall be entitled to free tuition fees. Grantees from Regions I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, ARMM, CARAGA and CAR will receive Two Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP2,400.00) stipend while those from NCR, Cebu City and Davao City shall receive One Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP1,400.00). All grantees are advised to travel by land or sea. Travel expenses shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies.

5. The Bureau of Elementary Education through the OSEC-HRTD Fund will give additional stipend of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) to all the trainees subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees, required documents directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City or call up Mr. Romeo M. **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF NOMINEES FOR THE SUMMER  
TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION**

1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder for the elementary or secondary level;
2. Is actually teaching regular or SPED classes without training at the elementary or secondary level for at least three (3) years with Very Satisfactory performance rating;
3. Has a grade point average of 2.0/85 or better/higher in the undergraduate/graduate/ post graduate study;
4. Is not more than 45 years of age;
5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother;
6. Has no administrative/criminal record;
7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and with positive attitude and commitment towards work, peers and students;
8. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses;
9. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years;
10. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.

REGIONAL INTEGRATED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE**

1. Complete Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet).
2. Certified True copy of Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods.
3. Certified true copy of Transcript of Records.
4. Form 86 (Health Certificate)
5. Certification from Head Office (Principal/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education/Secondary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommending him/her for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director
6. Duly accomplished Scholarship Contract (Memorandum of Agreement) MOA.

6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the visually impaired
7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training for a total of six (6) years;
8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Resources for the Blind, Inc. such sum of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine Government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the visually impaired for two (2) years after each summer training; and
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
