1. In support to the present thrust of the Department to establish Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools that will be put in place beginning SY 2009-2010, series of ICT trainings for teachers of Top 3 Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools shall be conducted this April to May 2009.

3. The objectives of these trainings are to:

- prepare the teachers in the implementation of ICT-enhanced curriculum for Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools which shall be rolled out beginning SY 2009-2010;
- upskill the ICT teachers of Regional ICT schools in their chosen ICT specializations; and
- for the teachers to undergo competency assessment immediately after the training

4. The list of teachers to be trained is provided in Enclosure 1. Teachers who are not included or enlisted shall not be accommodated.

5. Training guidelines shall be imposed for said trainings as provided in Enclosure 2.

6. Participants are expected to be at the venue a day before the start of the training for the orientation proper.

7. Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools will be required to offer PC Hardware Servicing as an additional mandated specialization and shall offer another ICT specialization/s from the following areas:

- a. Programming
- b. Networking
- c. Animation
- d. Visual Graphic Design
- e. IT Essentials
- f. CCNA Discovery

8. Transportation and other travel-related expenses of the participants are chargeable against local funds. Board and lodging expenses, honoraria, travel and per diem of facilitators, ICT trainers, training materials, consumables, supplies, function room rental, contingency and other incidental expenses are chargeable against OSEC Tech-Voc Funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
