FIRST NATIONAL LEARNING RESOURCES FAIR

- 1. The National Learning Strategy Technical Working Group (NLS-TWG) will conduct the First National Learning Resources Fair on April 15, 2009 at RELC, Davao City.
- 2. This Fair aims to:
 - a. showcase tested and effective digital and or non-digital instructional and supplementary materials developed by both non-DepED (i.e. NISMED, DOST, etc.) and local DepED educators (i.e., in the regions, divisions, or schools); and
 - b. select quality learning resources, which shall be reproduced under the Support for Philippine Education Reform (SPHERE) as a result of the Survey Questionnaire.
- 3. Members of the NLS-TWG will prioritize the recommended materials for mass production by SPHERE. Moreover, these members and representatives from the ICT Unit and Region XI shall facilitate the conduct of this Fair.
- 4. The participants are the Regional Directors and a maximum of two (2) participants from each of the fifty priority Divisions listed in Enclosure No.1. They are encouraged to have the Survey Questionnaire (Enclosure No.2) accomplished by their respective area supervisors and teachers.
- 5. Prior to this Fair, the educators who will participate shall submit two (2) copies for each learning material for evaluation to the Instructional Materials Council Secretariat (IMCS) or contact Ms. Rowena Espenida, 5th Floor Mabini Building, Department of Education (DepED) Central Office, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City at tel. nos. (02) 634-1072 / (02) 634-1054. Deadline for submission is on or before March 16, 2009.
- 6. Travel and other allowable expenses of the NLS-TWG will be charged against SPHERE funds. Travel expenses of participants will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
