PROJECT W.A.T.C.H. FIRST NATIONAL SUMMIT
(We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty)

1. DepED Memorandum Nos. 160 and 387 both series of 2008 announced that the DepED community will adopt and implement Project W.A.T.C.H. (**We Advocate Time Consciousness and Honesty**) to strengthen the value of punctuality and honesty as a significant step in bringing about fundamental change or transformation of society.

2. To be able to enhance the importance of punctuality and honesty, the National Executive Committee headed by the JCI Senate Philippines in coordination with its member agencies and associations (DepED, CHED, TESDA, Office of the Presidential Assistant in Education, PACU and PAPSCU) will conduct a three-day National Summit on W.A.T.C.H. on May 20-23, 2009 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "**Navigating the Philippine Main Education Highway through W.A.T.C.H.**". The Program of Activities is attached as Enclosure No. 1.


3. The objectives of the summit are to:

- a. address the need to return to the old-fashioned ethical values of honesty and punctuality;
- b. push forward the recognition of punctuality and honesty as two core values in promoting national renewal and development;
- c. gather stakeholders, government agencies, professional organizations, and civil society, assign specific tasks and pool resources (human and material) as they formulate short-term and long-term plans of implementation;
- d. renew educational momentum and commitment and to develop tools for consciousness and implementation in order to move from rhetoric to action; and
- e. highlight the critical role of values formation in nation-building.

4. Likewise, the Secretary is requesting all public and private schools and DepED offices (national, regional, division, and field offices) to post W.A.T.C.H signage (Enclosure No. 3) at the entrance gates and stickers in each classroom for awareness and reminder that punctuality and honesty are elements of success in our daily lives and also the recitation of the W.A.T.C.H. Prayer (Enclosure No. 2) before the opening of classroom activities in the morning and/or in the afternoon. 5. One of the highlights of the breakout session on the second day of the summit is to develop/ formulate the Guidelines and Mechanics of the Creation of the W.A.T.C.H. Clubs and W.A.T.C.H. school competition.
6. Participants to this activity are Regional Assistant Directors (17), Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (192), Regional Special Events Coordinators (17), Division Special Events Coordinators (192), School Principals, Subject Area Coordinators and institutional members of Boy and Girl Scouts Council. Attendance of the participants shall be on official business.
7. Private school principals and or subject area heads are encouraged to attend this summit. They are advised to make arrangements with their respective schools with regards to the registration fee and travel expenses.
8. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00) shall cover the board and lodging during the conference, meals (breakfast (3), snacks (6), lunch (3) and dinner (3)), seminar kits, materials, and honoraria for the speakers and facilitators. Meals shall be served starting p.m. snack of Day 0 and ending with lunch of Day 3.
9. Travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the National Secretariat (SEU) and other incidental expenses to be incurred to this summit shall be charged to OSEC funds while the travel expenses (transportation and per diem) and registration fee of the participants shall be charged to local funds (Regional/Division MOOE, PTA/PTCA funds, local school board funds and other sources) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The printing of conference materials, venue and equipment rentals, travel expenses of the speakers, and facilitators shall be borne by the JCI Senate Philippines W.A.T.C.H. Summit.
10. Members of the National Secretariat (SEU) and support staff are authorized to travel one (1) day before and after the scheduled summit.
11. For reservation purposes, participants are requested to confirm their attendance on or before April 30, 2009. 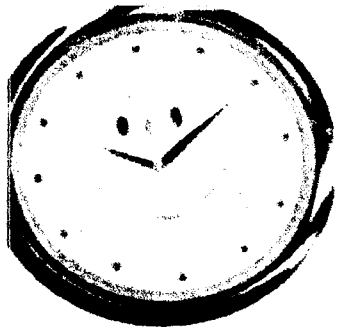

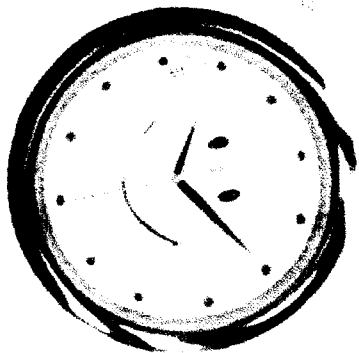
