STUDENT TECHNOLOGISTS AND ENTREPRENEURS OF THE PHILIPPINES  
ANNUAL EVALUATION AND PLANNING CONFERENCE AND WORKSHOP

1. Pursuant to DepED Order No. 35, s. 2008 on the Mandated Thrusts and Activities for the Student Technologists and Entrepreneurs of the Philippines (STEP) and DepED Order No. 73, s. 2003 on Strengthening the Student Technologists and Entrepreneurs of the Philippines (STEP) to Enhance the Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) of the Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), the Department of Education-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED-CSCA), in cooperation with the Bureau of Secondary Education, Bureau of Elementary Education and the Technical-Vocational Education Task Force, will conduct the STEP Annual Evaluation and Planning Conference and Workshop on May 12-17, 2009 in Malay, Aklan.

2. The STEP Annual Evaluation and Planning Conference and Workshop aims to achieve the following objectives:

- a. Evaluate the STEP program vis-à-vis the mandated thrusts and activities based on DepED Order No. 35, s. 2008, including the conduct of the 7<sup>th</sup> STEP-National Skills Development and Competitions (NSDC) held last November 19-24, 2008 in Baguio City;
- b. Identify and resolve issues and concerns pertinent to the STEP implementation;
- c. Update STEP vis-à-vis the Career Pathways of the Technology and Livelihood Education (CPTLE) and the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP);
- d. Craft/Codify rules, regulations and guidelines in the conduct of skills competitions;
- e. Review contest packages for the elementary, secondary and technical-vocational levels;
- f. Review and update the STEP Constitution and By-Laws; and
- g. Plan for the conduct of the 8<sup>th</sup> STEP-NSDC.

3. Participants to this conference are Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) Regional Supervisors/STEP Regional Coordinators, Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) Regional Supervisors/Coordinators, Technical-Vocational Education (TVE) Regional Coordinators, selected officers of the STEP National Board of Advisers Organization (NBAO), representatives from the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and Technical-Vocational Education Task

Force, invited resource persons, facilitators and experts, and staff of the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs.

4. Participants are expected to be at the venue before 12:00 NN on May 12, 2009. The CSCA shall shoulder board and lodging beginning lunch on May 12, 2009 until breakfast on May 17, 2009 only. Enclosed is the list of participants.

5. Travel and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds. Expenses for food and accommodation, supplies and materials and other incidental and necessary expenses, including transportation of DepED Central Office personnel and facilitators, shall be shouldered by the DepED-CSCA chargeable against DepED-OSEC funds.
