





GRADUATION CEREMONIES OF SMART MENTORS BATCH 1 OF THE SMART  
SCHOOLS PROGRAM ON MASTER OF ARTS IN INSTRUCTIONAL  
DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY (MA-IDT)

1. The Smart Schools Program, the flagship community service initiative of Smart Communications, Inc. through the Department of Education and Philippine Business for Social Progress in collaboration with the University of Makati and Learn.ph Foundation will be holding the graduation ceremony of the first batch of 23 secondary public school teachers who were awarded as scholars under the Smart Mentors Program.
2. The Smart Mentors Program was launched in December 2008 where it provided select public high school teachers - dubbed as Smart Mentors - a venue to showcase their ICT skills in the field of teaching and learning environment. The mentoring program included scholarship for a 12-month course offered through modular and mentored action research. Completion of the action research course entitled the Smart Mentors to earn a degree in Master of Arts in Instructional Design and Technology (MA-IDT).
3. Twenty-three Smart Mentors successfully passed the panel defense and completed their thesis requirements. They will officially join the graduation ceremony on April 24, 2009 to be held at the University of Makati, J.P. Rizal Ext., West Rembo, Makati City. The list of graduating scholars is enclosed.
4. Smart Mentors' inclusive dates of travel will be on April 23-25, 2009. The Smart Schools Program, through the Philippine Business for Social Progress (PBSP) shall cover the cost of teachers' travel, meals and accommodation on the specified dates. The attendance of the participants shall be on official time only.
