5-DAY TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON THE PILOT IMPLEMENTATION  
OF THE SPECIAL PROGRAM IN JOURNALISM (SPJ) YEAR 1

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) shall conduct a pilot implementation of the Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) in 17 public secondary schools nationwide in school year 2009-2010. In preparation for the field test of the program, a 5-day Training-Workshop on the Pilot Implementation of the Special Program in Journalism Year 1 shall be held on May 25-29, 2009 at the Marikina Hotel, Marikina City.

2. The training-workshop aims to:


- a. hone/enrich the journalistic skills and competencies of student-writers;
- b. strengthen free and responsible journalism in secondary schools;
- c. identify areas of development in various aspects of journalism;
- d. orient the participants on the program, its scope, target clientele, implementing guidelines and its learning competencies; and
- e. ensure commitment and shared responsibility towards the attainment of program goals.

3. The participants to the training-workshop are the following:

- 17 Journalism I Teachers
- 17 Advanced English 1 Teachers
- 17 Principals
- 17 Division Supervisors
- 2 Resource Persons
- 2 Consultants

4. The list of the 17 identified pilot schools with the name of the Journalism and Advanced English 1 teachers is enclosed for reference.

5. Check-in shall be on May 24 from 2:00 p.m. onwards, with dinner as the first meal. Check-out shall be after p.m. snacks of May 30, 2009.
6. The traveling expenses of the participants mentioned in Item No. 3, which shall be reimbursed at the training venue upon presentation of complete travel documents shall be charged against BSE funds, except for the 17 Division Supervisors in-charge of the program who shall charge their expenses against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging of all participants and BSE staff, honoraria of resource persons and consultants, supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses shall be borne by BSE. Participants are advised to get the cheapest means of transportation to and from the training venue.
