ALS ALUMNI HOMECOMING AND RECOGNITION OF ACHIEVERS

1. The Philippine Association of Nonformal Educators, Inc. (PANFEI) announces the holding of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Alumni Homecoming and Recognition of Achievers at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on August 18-20, 2009 with the theme "ALS Alumni: People with Substance" (Ganito Kami Noon... Paano Kayo Ngayon?).
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. provide Life Long Learning (LLL) experiences within a virtual ALS context;
 - b. disseminate ALS research results and impact of the A&E program;
 - c. present ALS programs and other initiatives;
 - d. recognize role models and best practices in ALS; and
 - e. enhance the grand alliance of ALS network.
3. The activity is open to all the ALS implementers, partners, and stakeholders. The following are authorized to attend: DepED Key Officials, ALS Regional Division Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs, Education Supervisor II, Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Education Supervisor I in charge of ALS, Regional and Division Planning Officers, Budget Officers, Accountants, Public Schools District Supervisors, Principals, School Heads, Principal Coordinators of BP-OSA schools, District ALS Coordinators, and ALS Mobile Teachers.
4. The activity shall be managed by the PANFEI, through the different committees that shall be organized composed of its current officers and Board of Directors. The Secretariat shall be composed of selected BALS staff. Members of the different committees and the secretariat shall be authorized to travel two days before the actual conduct of the activity. Attendance to this activity will be on official business.

5. This is a live-in activity. Participants are requested to register on August 17, 2009. The first meal to be served will be dinner on August 17 and last meal will be breakfast on August 21, 2009.



A registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) shall be charged each participant and committee members to cover board and lodging, professional fee of speakers, materials, handouts, kits, supplies and other related conference expenditures. Payments may be made in cash or cheque in the name of PANFEI. Early registrants covering the period up to June 15, 2009 will be given a Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) discount.
