2ND PHILIPPINE BORDER JAMBOREE

- 1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will conduct the 2nd Philippine Border Jamboree at the Zamboanga Ecozone and Freeport Authority, San Ramon, Zamboanga City on May 21-26, 2009.
- 2. With the theme "Scouts: Creating a Better World", this activity aims to:
 - a. practice daily good turns to instill a sense of social responsibility among Scouts;
 - b. improve leadership skills and ability to work as a team;
 - c. appreciate the cultural and historical heritage of the host city.
