## BRIEFING ON THE OPERATIONALIZATION OF REGIONAL ICT TECH-VOC HIGH SCHOOLS AND ITS OFFICIAL LAUNCHING

- 1. In support to the main objectives of the ICT4E Program and Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program (STVEP) of the Department, Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools shall be opened to serve as the Center of Excellence in ICT.
- 2. Pursuant to the ICT4E Strategic Plan, these Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools shall offer a wide range of ICT specializations leading to local and international certifications in ICT.
- 3. To be able to determine these schools, a Regional Assessment and Inventory of ICT facilities of the 282 tech-voc high schools was conducted per DepED Memorandum No. 550, s. 2008 which aimed to determine the level of readiness of said schools in terms of implementing ICT specializations of which results was announced through DepED Memorandum No. 91, s. 2009.
- 4. To prepare the teachers of said schools in the implementation of the ICT-enabled curriculum, series of ICT Trainings for the Top 3 Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools was conducted pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 138, s. 2009 that aims primarily to upgrade the skills of the ICT teachers and for them to acquire local and international certifications in ICT.
- 5. As provided for in the ICT4E Strategic Plan, Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools will be opened beginning SY 2009-2010. For the efficient and effective implementation of these special schools, a briefing on the operationalization of Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools and its official launching shall be held on June 25-26, 2009 at Marikina Hotel, Marikina City. Enclosed is the list of participants.

- 6. The main objectives of this activity are to:
  - a. orient the participants about the ICT4E Strategic Plan provisions for tech-voc education particularly the establishment of Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools which serve as the Regional ICT Center of Excellence;
  - b. discuss to the participants the ICT-enabled curriculum of the Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools;
  - c. brief the participants on the operationalization of said schools:
  - d. formulate a 3-year implementation plan (2009-2012) and a supervisory plan for Regional ICT Tech-Voc High Schools; and
  - e. distribute the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) and Contextual Learning Matrices (CLM) of ICT specializations.
- 7. Participants are expected to be at the venue a day before the start of the program. First meal to be served is dinner on June 24, 2009.
