NATIONAL FORUM ON GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP

1. The Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA) of the Philippines will conduct a National Forum on Global Citizenship for Youth Club Advisers and Program Staff on July 16-18, 2009 at the Hotel Indah Manila, YMCA of the Philippines Bldg., 350 A.J. Villegas Street, Ermita, Manila.
2. The forum aims to:
 - a. provide space for YMCA leaders and youth club advisers to reflect on the concept and impacts of globalization and their social responsibilities as global citizens and active agents of change in their communities, and within their own local movements;
 - b. develop a contextual working framework of the concept of global citizenship and identify its imperatives in relation to the contextual mission of the movement; and
 - c. engage the participants in a learning process, critically reflecting on issues affecting them and formulate practical and relevant prioritized action responses.
3. The participants of this forum are Youth Club advisers who are handling College-Y, Hi-Y and Red Triangle Clubs in various elementary, high schools and colleges and universities in the country, program staff of local YMCAs and youth and women leaders. Participants from public schools are encouraged to attend **on official time only**.
4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover operational expenses such as food, accommodation, materials, miscellaneous and other related expenses.
