PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS COMPETITIONS (PIMC) 2009

1. The Mathematics Trainers' Guild (MTG) of the Philippines will host the 2009 Asia-Inter-Cities Teenagers Mathematics Olympiad (AITMO) and the 2009 Philippine Elementary Mathematics International Contest (PEMIC) dubbed as the Philippine International Mathematics Competitions (PIMC) 2009 to be held from November 28 to December 2, 2009 in Iloilo City.
  2. Participants to these international Mathematics competitions are students, coaches, math educators, and parents from thirty countries in Asia, Africa, North America, Australia and Europe.
  3. Alongside with these competitions, regional and national Mathematics contests based on international rules will be conducted for Mathematics gifted local public and private school students who have never experienced joining international Mathematics competitions. This approach will further enhance the mathematical skills of Filipino students vis-à-vis their international counterparts.
  4. The objectives of the competitions are to:
    - a. encourage Filipino students to enhance their mathematical skills to meet the international standards and help them in their undergraduate courses in the future; and
    - b. support the overall government's thrust to inculcate among regular Filipino students a deeper appreciation of Mathematics, the essential language of Science.
  5. The conduct of regional and national competitions will enable the MTG to provide intensive training among the winners who will be participating at the PIMC 2009.
