## FIFTH NATIONAL CHEERLEADING SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

- 1. The Cheerleading Association of the Philippines, Inc. (CLAP) will hold its 5<sup>th</sup> National Cheerleading Seminar-Workshop on October 23-25, 2009 at Cebu Normal University, Cebu City which aims to promote cheerleading in the Philippines as a good form of developing good citizens through wholesome activities embodied in this new sport.
- 2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
  - a. instill proper practice of safety measures in all activities of cheerleading; inspire administrators to be involved in the cheer programs; full awareness of all coaches and cheerleaders of safety responsibilities plus parents' support and knowledge of safety rules;
  - perform specific skills in selected dance genre, stunting techniques and pyramid building;
  - c. acquire insights in organizing and managing a cheer team; and
  - d. prepare a sample cheerleading training program.
- 3. The participants to this activity are physical education/dance and cheerleading supervisors, teachers, coordinators, coaches, trainors, and cheerleading enthusiasts. Participation will be on **official time only**, subject further to approval of immediate supervisors.

Each participant will be charged a course fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) to cover the cost of morning and afternoon snacks, venue rental, CLAP t-shirt and bag, materials, special prizes, certificates, equipment and facilities rental, honoraria and airfare of resource persons and other miscellaneous items.
