2009 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

- 1. In celebration of the annual Literacy Week, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation and coordination with other Government Organizations (GOs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Private Organizations (POs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), will hold the National Literacy Conference from September 29 to October 1, 2009 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. In line with the priority agenda of the United Nations Literacy Decade (UNLD 2003-2012), the theme of this year's conference is "Literacy Empowerment: Key to Community Development".
- 3. The objectives of the conference are to:
 - a. strengthen the local and national commitment to literacy advocacy, information and communication;
 - b. sustain local initiatives and practices for lifelong learning;
 - c. design strategies to increase access of nonliterate individuals to literacy resources; and
 - d. serve as a venue for sharing experiences in implementing literacy programs for community development.
- 4. The following participants are expected to attend the conference **on official business:**
 - a. Bureau, Center and Regional Directors or their representatives, Bureau/Regional Chiefs, Supervisors, Coordinators and Mobile Teachers of the Alternative Learning System;
 - b. Schools Division Superintendents or Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Principals/Head Teachers of Elementary and Secondary Public and Private Schools, especially those from the 5th and 6th Class Municipalities/Districts, Provinces included in the 30 focused barangays with lowest literacy rates (Please see enclosed list);
 - c. Officers of government agencies with extension programs involving literacy or continuing education;
 - d. Heads and members of Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) involved in universalizing literacy in every region;

- e. Heads of Local Government Units (LGUs), Barangay Chairmen, Kagawad and officers involved in the universalization of literacy;
- f. Heads of Private/Corporate Foundations with interest in education or literacy; and
- g. Heads and members of academic institutions particularly those in charge of National Service Training Program-Literacy Training Service (NSTP-LTS).
- 5. One of the highlights of the conference is the awarding of National Literacy Hall of Fame Awards to two (2) Outstanding Local Government Units for their exemplary accomplishments in literacy development through their programs and projects.
- 6. This is a live-in conference. Participants are requested to register on September 29, 2009 at anytime between 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. The first meal to be served will be lunch on September 29, and the last meal to be served will be breakfast on October 2, 2009.
- 7. A registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits, and other workshop supplies and materials. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
