- Presidential Proclamation No. 267 declares the month of October of every year as the National Children's Month to emphasize the importance of the role of the child within the Filipino family and within the Philippine society. This year, the Department of Education (DepED) joins the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) in celebrating the National Children's Month.
- The month-long celebration anchored on the theme "Bright Child: Proteksyon ng Bata, Pananagutan ng Bansa", aims to support the campaign to end violence against children and to promote their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being.

 - Conduct of contests on showcase of talents (art/poster and slogan making, photo exhibit, children's fair, etc.)
