DEPED ADVANCED eXCELS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR SY 2009-2010

- 1. The DepED Advanced eXCELS Scholarship Program is offered to provide school heads with opportunities for continuing education and training in advanced level tasks through competency-based, multi-modal, modularized flexible learning courses that utilize a web-based learning management platform known as the INNOTECH Flexible Learning Management System or iFLEX. The **DepED Advanced eXCELS Program for SY 2009-2010** consists of the following courses:
 - a. TEACHEXCELS or Teaching-Learning Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia is a two-module, four-week online learning short course designed to enhance the instructional leadership skills of school heads in managing and supporting the teaching-learning processes in schools. Course fee is Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP22,500.00) per participant;
 - b. SUPEREXCELS or Supervision Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia is a three-module, six-week online learning short course designed to enhance skills and management techniques in development, differentiated, and clinical supervision for school heads who conduct instructional supervision. Course fee is Thirty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP35,000.00) per participant; and
 - c. TECHeXCELS or Technology Excellence in School Leadership for Southeast Asia is a two-module, four-week online learning short course designed to build the capacity of school heads to manage the integration and application of technologies in the teaching-learning process. Course fee is Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP22,500.00) per participant.
- 2. To qualify for scholarship to the above-described DepED Advanced eXCELS courses, the school head must have successfully completed the DepED ICeXCELS course and identified as requiring more focused instruction and training in the advanced level tasks of teaching-learning excellence, instructional supervision excellence and technology excellence. Preference shall be given to those occupying the position for more than three years.

- 3. Each of the DepED Advanced eXCELS courses are creditable with at least three (3) academic units for an appropriate graduate/post-graduate degree program from any sixteen (16) accredited teacher education institutions in the Philippines with whom SEAMEO INNOTECH has a partnership agreement provided that the eXCELS graduates are certified by SEAMEO INNOTECH as having acquired certain prescribed competencies.
- 4. Authority is hereby given for the use of local funds for the enrolment of elementary and/or secondary school heads to any course of the DepED Advanced eXCELS Program for SY 2009-2010. In order to make the most of the scholarship program, enrolment shall be limited to only one (1) course per individual school head.
