5th NATIONAL CONVENTION OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES COORDINATORS AND DEPED ENGINEERS

- 1. The Department of Education is persistent to find ways in uplifting the performance of its employees which will contribute to the over-all ratings of the Department to contribute in sustaining this, the Physical Facilities and Schools' Engineering Division (PFSED) will hold its 5th National Convention of Physical Facilities Coordinators and DepED Engineers on December 7-9, 2009 (exclusive of travel time) at Bacolod City with the theme: "Building State of the Art Learning Facilities Through New Trends in Technology".
- 2. The convention aims to:
 - a. Assess the status of various projects, discuss issues and concerns that affects the immediate completion;
 - b. Update the participants with the latest guidelines, procedures and management policies as applied to the implementation of projects;
 - c. Provide inputs to the CY 2010 Action Plans for Physical Facilities of Divisions, Regions and Central Office:
 - d. Plan for better management of projects and renew commitments among Physical Facilities Coordinators, Project Engineers and PFSED staff to enhance performance and teamwork.
 - e. Assessment on disaster risk reduction and preparedness among schools, and;
 - f. Introduce the advancement of technology in building construction.

- 3. Participants to this convention are Regional and Division Physical Facilities Coordinators, DepED Lead/Project Engineers, PFSED staff and selected staff from the Central Office.
- 4. Participants are requested to bring their status report of projects being implemented in their respective areas and their laptop computers for the workshop. A display area will be available for materials for exhibition during the convention.
- 5. Participants are expected to be at the venue by Sunday afternoon, December 6, 2009. Attendance to this activity shall be on official business.
- 6. A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover payment for convention materials, contingencies and honoraria of resource speakers, facilitators and staff.
- 7. Participants shall charge their transportation and registration fees against the School Building Program's Engineering and Administrative Overhead (EAO) Monitoring Funds or at any available local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Traveling expenses of PFSED and selected staff from the Central Office shall be charged against the Engineering and Administrative Overhead (EAO) funds of the School Building Program of the Department, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Funds for board and lodging of all participants shall be charged to the EAO of the Central Office and shall be transferred to DepED Regional Office VI as the host of the convention.
