The Department of Education (DepED) in coordination with the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), and Philippine Council for Advanced Science and Technology, Research and Development (PCASTRD) will celebrate the 5th National Biotechnology Week on November 22-29, 2009 with the theme "Bioteknolohiya para sa Kalikasan, Kalusugan, Kagandahan, Kabuhayan at Kaunlaran".
