52ND NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS
OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION

1. The 52nd National Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education (NCCACEE) will be held on November 16-20, 2009 at the Oxford Hotel, M. Roxas St., corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark, Special Economic Zone, Pampanga.
2. The conference will focus on the theme "Enhancing the EPP Curriculum: A Way to Help Eradicate Poverty and Hunger". The conference aims to:
 - a. identify areas in the Edukasyong Pantahan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) curriculum where possible actions can be included/incorporated to help eradicate poverty;
 - b. share EPP-based existing practices that help mitigate poverty related school problems;
 - c. revisit and fine tune EPP proposals;
 - d. gain insights on possible partnership areas in implementing EPP proposals; and
 - e. determine the status of implementation of policies.
3. The participants to this conference are the thirty four (34) Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Division (EED) in the regions and the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), BEE Director, Assistant Director and selected Education Program Specialists (EPSs) from BEE. 4. Attendance to this activity shall be **on official business**. A registration fee of Seven Thousand Pesos (PhP7,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials, resource persons' fee and other related expenses. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
