NATIONAL TEACHER TRAINING WORKSHOP ON THE MULTI-MEDIA APPROACH IN TEACHING ASEAN CULTURE

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

All Others Concerned

- 1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the National Council for Children's Television (NCCT) with the Department of Education's Culture and Arts Office (CAO) will conduct a National Teacher Training Workshop on the Multi-Media Approach in Teaching the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Culture on November 27-29, 2009 at the National Educators Academy of the Philippines-XI, Quirino Avenue, Davao City-
- 2. The workshop fulfills the mandate of NCCA to promote the culture and history of the Philippines and other member-countries of the ASEAN (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam) to teachers and students all over the country. It also fulfills one of the thrusts of NCCT to effectively use media in education with the use of CDRoms, videos, TV films, posters and other multi-media materials in teacher training and in teaching. The program of activities is in Enclosure No. 1.
- 3. The goals of this teacher training are to:
 - a. introduce the ASEAN culture multi-media materials to the teachers of the 17 DepEd-designated schools with Special Program in the Arts (SPA) and to increase their awareness and appreciation of the culture of the Philippines and the membercountries of the ASEAN;
 - b. train teachers to utilize computer-based ASEAN culture materials contained in the CDRom, and integrate these in their subjects with written lesson plans demonstrating this integration;
 - c. promote the blended-learning approach in teaching by encouraging teachers to use a variety of teaching methods: dramatizations; art production; group activities; use of computers and other multi-media materials to enrich the teaching of their subjects; and
 - d. share the multi-media materials and blended learning approaches with other teachers in other schools in their divisions through sharing sessions by the participants in this workshop.
- 4. The participants to this activity are permanent teachers from the 17 regional schools with Special Program in the Arts (Enclosure No. 2). Each school is requested to send only four (4) teachers, preferably teaching second year English, Science or Mathematics, History, Art, Music, Drama or Dance. Other schools with special program in the arts will be considered if anyone of the 17 SPA Lead Schools cannot send participants, as participation to this workshop is limited.

- 5. Attendance of participants shall be on official business. A registration fee of Three Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP3,700.00) will cover expenses for board and lodging at the National Educators Academy of the Philippines-XI, Davao City on November 26-30, 2009. Participants are expected to be at the venue on November 26 in the afternoon (first meal is dinner) and to leave on November 30, 2009 in the morning (last meal is breakfast). Participants' expenses for travel, board and lodging, and other incidental expenses, may be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
