TRAINING OF PRIVATE SCHOOL HEALTH PERSONNEL ON SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

To: Bureau Directors

- 1. The Philippine Academy of Physicians in School Health, Inc. (PAPSHI) will hold its Training of Private School Health Personnel on School Health Program Implementation on November 23-25, 2009 at the Bayanihan Center, Unilab Laboratories, Inc., Pioneer St., Mandaluyong City (opposite Chowking Restaurant or Pioneer Center (PC)).
- 2. The objectives of training are to:
 - a. update school health personnel and administrators on planning and management of the school health program;
 - b. update them on the World Health Organization (WHO) components of a school health program;
 - c. acquaint them on the roles of the school administrators, physicians, dentists and nurses in the implementation of the school health program; and
 - d. acquire general knowledge on how to plan, implement and evaluate the school health program.
- 3. In view of the technical benefits that can be gained from this training, regional directors and schools division superintendents are hereby encouraged to allow their medical officers to attend on **official business**. Participants from private schools shall make necessary arrangements with their respective schools/institutions.
- 4. Participants who will complete the training module will be given a certificate that will acknowledge them as school health consultants.
- 5. The registration fee is Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) to cover meals, module materials and other expenses.
