- 1. Due to the calamities caused by the typhoons "Ondoy" and Pepeng, the Reading Association of the Philippines (RAP) Midyear Demofest which will be held on November 12-14, 2009, as announced in DepEd Memorandum No. 418, s. 2009 has been reset to January 21-23, 2010 at CSI Stadia in Dagupan City, Pangasinan.

- *** Annual membership fee is PhP500.00. A member of good standing is entitled to a free copy of the latest RAP Journal and a discounted rate in every RAP organized conference.
