ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 379, S. 2009  
(2010 National Schools Press Conference)



1. The following are additional information to DepED Memorandum No. 379, s. 2009:

- a. DepEd Region XI, Tagum City, Davao del Norte shall host the 2009-2010 National Schools Press Conference on February 22-26, 2010;
- b. Each participant shall pay a registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) inclusive of a tour package within Tagum City;
- c. Delegates who will arrive midnight may take meals at some fast food chains available within twenty four (24) hours, at their own cost;
- d. Selected First Year High School students from the Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) will join this year's NSPC as discussed and agreed during the National Orientation Workshop on Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) for Regional Coordinators in September and in the Monitoring and Evaluation of SPJ Pilot Schools in October and November. These student-journalists shall participate in the following individual contests in English such as Copy Reading and Headline Writing, News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing and Editorial Cartooning;
- e. Travelling expenses and registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) of the SPJ delegates shall be charged against local funds;
- f. The host division shall assign additional fourteen (14) pax per billeting quarter with a total of two hundred twenty six (226) delegates per region: two hundred twelve (212) participants as stated in Enclosure No. 3 of DepED Memorandum No. 379, s. 2009; six (6) SPJ student journalists, pilot teacher in Journalism and their school head; two (2) Regional Coordinators (elementary and secondary) and two (2) Presidents, Regional Association of the School Paper Advisers and two (2) Advisers of the Editors Guilds (elementary and secondary);
- g. Deadline for the submission of official regional delegates shall be January 15, 2010 using the revised Confirmation Sheet. Please see Enclosure No. 1;
- h. The accommodation of those who are not members of the official delegation, like parents, school heads and other officials may be arranged with the assistance of the host division, chargeable to the personal account of the non-official delegate;



- i. The contests in Scriptwriting and Radio Broadcasting shall be done in both English and Filipino. Each participant is advised to bring his/her own laptop and a 5-meter extension cord;
  - j. Each delegation should hand in their Regional Banner to the host region during the general orientation on February 22, 2010, 8:00-9:00 a.m., Monday at the Audio-Visual Room, Tagum City National High School;
  - k. Travel arrangements and other concerns should be coursed through Dr. Edgar V. Sangalang, Chairman, Transportation Committee, Division of Tagum City at tel. nos. (084) 218-2166; (084) 217-2326 or at mobile phone no.: 0909-6843865;
  - l. Results of the top three (3) regional winning entries of the different categories in the individual contests may be sent through e-mail at [veckcervantes@yahoo.com](mailto:veckcervantes@yahoo.com)/[bhoiegutierrez@yahoo.com](mailto:bhoiegutierrez@yahoo.com) following the given Excel format. Please see Enclosure No. 2;
  - m. The list of the top three (3) Outstanding School Paper Advisers shall be submitted to the Region XI Presidents of the Regional Elementary School Paper Advisers Association (RESPAA) and Regional Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (RSSPAA). The list of Outstanding Regional Campus Journalists shall be forwarded to the Presidents of the National Elementary Editors Guild (NEEG) and National Secondary Editors Guild (NSEG), copy furnished the Bureau of Elementary and Secondary Education, respectively;
  - n. Topics for the concurrent sessions shall include the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), Editorial Writing with Cartooning, Feature Writing, Photojournalism (Digital) and School Paper Management and Page Lay-Out. Participants to the sessions will be given a color-coded coupon to indicate the session they will attend. Sessions for elementary shall be held at Assumpta School of Davao and for secondary will be at St. Mary's College; and
  - o. Draft copy of the NSPC 2010 Program of Activities is also enclosed for reference. Please see Enclosure No. 3.
