III. **SELECTION OF MODEL SCHOOL CHILDREN**

A. Each school shall form its committee to select its model pupils/students at least one (1) boy and one (1) girl in each level. More may be named for each level as long as such pupils/students satisfy the criteria laid down. It is suggested that there be separate committee for each level.

NOTE: 1. A school offering the primary course only shall submit a minimum of one boy and one girl. The same is true in the case of a school offering only the intermediate courses shall select a minimum of 6 model boys and girls, or a minimum total of 12 model youth.

2. A School offering literary and adult education course for out-of-school youth (8-20 yrs.) shall submit a minimum of one model out-of-school boy and one out-of-school girl.

B. Each school is requested to submit just one copy of the information sheet of each model school pupil/student selected.

C. Name and information sheets (form is hereto attached) of model pupils/students should be submitted to CHILDREN'S MUSEUM AND LIBRARY, INC. at the given address.

IV. **AWARDING CEREMONIES**

Awarding ceremonies as part of an appropriate program shall be held simultaneously in the different schools on "**Recognition Day**" during the celebration of the Children's and Youth Achievement Week annually sponsored by the CMLI, during commencement exercise or fitting special celebration. Citations or Certificates of Recognition for each of the model pupils/students shall be furnished free by the CMLI and shall be made available upon submission of names of model pupils/students at the CMLI Headquarters. Medals may be awarded to the model adult-education youths, if the Finance Committee is able to receive funds for the purpose from such possible sources as the PTA, Faculty Club, Student Council and other source.

V. **CRITERIA AND MEMBERSHIP FEE**

▶ Criteria for the selection is hereto attached. CMLI membership fee of each Model school student/pupil is twenty five pesos (**Php25.00**). Though not compulsory, medals may be awarded to Model Youth. A 25 Karat gold plated medals bearing the CMLI seal are available at the CMLI Secretariat. 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GUIDELINES

OBJECTIVES: To develop in the youth a greater sense of responsibility, maintenance and improvement of their health, as individual and a as a member of the family and community.

I. COORDINATING COMMITTEE IN EACH DIVISION OR REGION

Chairman: Regional Directors, Bureau Directors
Members: Division Superintendents, Heads of Colleges and/or Universities with Elementary and High School.

II. LOCAL ACTIONS COMMITTEE ON THE SCHOOL LEVEL

Chairman: Community Leader (Note: Chairmanship should be rotated every year.)
Members: Chairman of the various subcommittee named below: PTA Officers or Members, Barangay Officials/Active Members, and Civic Leaders.
Coordinators: School Authority

III. SUB-COMMITTEE

- SELECTION COMMITTEE - to select the model pupils, children/out-of-school youth.
PROGRAM - to take charge of convocations and details on the presentation of awards as well as other activities that fall within the province of this committee.
INVITATION - to take charge of inviting guest speakers, parents, civic and religious associations and other community leaders/groups to the award program.
REPORTS AND SCRAPBOOKS - this committee will compile pictures of the model children, prepare scrapbook providing a copy each for the schools, the Division and the National Headquarters.
PUBLIC RELATIONS - this committee will:
1. Publicize model children and this project in local papers.
2. See to the installation at a conspicuous place in school of a "roll of honor" black board whereon names of model children shall be written.
3. Coordinate efforts to spread information about this project in the community.
WAYS AND MEANS (Finance) - this committee will be responsible for soliciting necessary funds from PTA, etc., for the purchase of medals and other needs.
SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES - this committee will scout for talented student/pupils, refer them to the local philanthropies or civic spirited persons who may sponsor their studies, and/or refer them for screening to the CMLI for possible adoption as scholar.

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A-1 FILIPINO CHILDREN

I. This project is open to all bonafide Filipino Elementary School Pupils and Secondary School Students.

II. The A - 1 Filipino Child shall be judged on the following bases:

a. PHYSICAL ATTRIBUTES ----- 50%

- Height/Weight (gains eight and height regularly, wellnourished)
- Skin
- Musculature
- Posture
- Cleanliness/neatness
- Teeth (complete, clean, corrected, etc.)
- Eyes
- Free from skin diseases
- Etc.

b. MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT ----- 30%

- Cheerful disposition
- Satisfactory class achievement
- Smooth interpersonal relationship
- Cooperativeness
- Honesty, Respectfulness, etc.

c. IMMUNIZATION ----- 10%

(the child must have at least five immunizations)

d. CLEANLINESS OF ENVIRONMENT ----- 10%

III. SELECTION

1. Each school shall select one (1) boy and one (1) girl from each grade level based on the health records of students and criteria for selection, and among them, one will be judged as an A-1 Child.
2. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be held final. The results and list of A-1 Children should be submitted to the CMLI Secretariat at the given address.

IV. AWARDS

▶ A-1 Children shall be given free citations or certificates by the CMLI and shall be made available after submission of the names of awardees at the CMLI, duly certified by the respective Board of Judges.

V. CRITERIA AND MEMBERSHIP FEE

▶ Criteria for the selection is hereto attached. CMLI membership fee of each A-1 Child is twenty five pesos (**Php25.00**). Though not compulsory, medals may be awarded to the A - 1 Children. A 25 Karat gold plated medals bearing the CMLI seal are available at the CMLI Secretariat. Civic spirited citizens or organizations may sponsor awardees medals.
