FIRST NATIONAL SECONDARY LEVEL ComArts (ENGLISH) FESTIVAL

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- 1. The World Class Language Center and the Association of English Educators in the Philippines, in coordination with the Philippines English Language Teachers Association Region XI (PELTA XI) through the National Council for Children's Television (NCCT) will sponsor the First National Secondary Level Communication Arts (English) Festival on March 4-6, 2010 in Olongapo City National High School, Subic, Olongapo City with the theme "Enhancing Skills in Communication Arts Through Healthy Competitions".
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. enhance the artistic and creative talents and skills of learners;
 - b. deepen students' knowledge on Communication Arts in English.
- 3. The contestants are the first placers in the Regional Level Competition in the following events:
 - a. On-the-Spot Jingle Writing Cum Interpretation and Presentation
 - b. Reader's Theatre/Reading Interpretation in four (4) categories:
 - Solo
 - One contestant per Region
 - Duo/Pair
 - One pair per Region
 - Trio
 - Consists of three (3) members
 - Group
 - Minimum of ten (10) participants but not to exceed twelve (12)
 - c. Dance Theatre Arts
 - d. The Art of Smart Talking
- 4. The other participants are the Coaches/Advisers, Division and Regional Secondary Education Program Supervisors in English, School Principals, SED Chiefs/Assistant Chiefs, Officers of PELTA, NEAP and Schools Division Superintendents/Assistant Schools Division Superintendents. Participation to this activity is **on official business**.



- 5. The mechanics/guidelines and criteria of the different contests are enclosed. There will be concurrent sessions on public speaking, the act of developing self confidence and personality development.
- 6. The following is the schedule of activities:

Division Level – December 2009 to January 2010 Regional Level – January 16, 2010 to February 2010 National Level – March 4-6, 2010

- 7. A registration fee of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP2,800.00) shall be charged each participant. This will be paid directly to the Treasurers of the sponsoring associations for the meals, snacks, lodging, certificates, trophies, cash prizes, honoraria of judges and lecturers, facilitators and other incidental expenses of the Management Staff. All expenses incurred by each participant in relation to this activity are charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The first meal shall be dinner of March 4 and the last meal shall be lunch of March 6, 2010.

Mechanics/ Guidelines/ Criteria of the Competition

A. Contestants

- Contestants are bona-fide high school students from the public or private schools.
- ✓ They are the 1st place winners in the Regional Level Competition

General Guidelines:

- 1. Language to be used is English
- 2. The decision of the panel of judges is final and irrevocable
- ✓ Name of the contestants in each event and respective coaches shall be submitted to the Secretariat not later than March 4, 2010 or during the Registration Period at the venue.
- ✓ All deliveries shall be timed by a timekeeper who will be introduced before the contest.
- ✓ Drawing of lots shall be done before the contest proper. This shall be done only once, i.e each Region shall maintain one number.
- ✓ A short opening program will start at 9:00 a.m on March 4, 2010.
- ✓ The contest mechanics/ criteria of each event shall be strictly observed.

 - 3-5 lines only (2-3 sentences)
 - Topic to be given on the spot during the writing contest
