2010 SACEDA YOUTH LEAD INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP CAMP

1. The Saceda Youth Lead will hold its **Annual International Leadership Camp** on April 15-23, 2010 at the SYL Center, Purok Gumamela, Candau-ay, Dumaguete City with the theme "Re-uniting the Youth of Today for a Safer and Better Tomorrow".

2. The objectives of this camp are to:

- a. provide the youth the opportunity to re-examine, re-learn and understand genuine values as applied to current leadership practices;
- b. study systems and structures that promote values development and transformation; and
- c. formulate viable objectives that will translate national thrusts into specific plans that can be implemented in the local, provincial, national and international levels.

3. Invited to this activity are student leaders, out-of-school youth from different organizations, elementary and secondary student leaders, college students, other interested students, teachers handling student governments and NGO workers focused on youth empowerment and development. The camp is divided into three sections or levels:

Junior Level	elementary and high school students
Senior Level	college students
Educators	teachers and professionals

Each section or level will have separate activities to be done simultaneously.
