GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CY 2010 QUICK RESPONSE FUND (1ST BATCH)

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

All Others Concerned

- 1. Under the CY 2010 proposed budget, a Quick Response Fund (QRF) was allocated to address the immediate requirements for the repair/rehabilitation of school buildings damaged by various typhoons, burned school buildings and other facilities affected by natural calamities.
- 2. The corresponding list of priority projects under this budget shall be provided by the Physical Facilities and Schools' Engineering Division (PFSED) to the implementing offices. It shall be drawn from the long list of affected schools reported to PFSED subject to validation.
- 3. In preparation of the program of works, the regional and division Physical Facilities Coordinators (PFCs) and DepEd Project Engineers (DPEs) must ensure that the targeted number of classrooms in the approved list shall be complied or even surpass in the actual implementation in order to maximize the use of funds.
- 4. Procurement and implementation shall be done in the Division Offices. Due to the urgency of implementation and completion of these projects, the Division Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) can adopt the Negotiated Procurement following Section 53.2 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184. The Division BAC shall start the procurement process while waiting for the Sub-Allotment Release Order (SARO) in order to meet the schedule of the Election Ban which starts on March 26, 2010.
- 5. To ensure that the school buildings can be used at the start of School Year 2010-2011, frontloading of the construction of school buildings during the long summer vacation period shall be made.

6. For widest dissemination and compliance of all concerned.
