7<sup>TH</sup> COURSE ON FOOD SAFETY

1. The Department of Nutrition, College of Public Health, University of the Philippines (CPH-UP) Manila will hold its 7<sup>th</sup> Course on Food Safety on April 19-23, 2010 at the Press Room, Annex II Building of the College of Public Health, 625 Pedro Gil St., Manila.
