**24<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE EDSA PEOPLE POWER REVOLUTION**

1. The EDSA People Power Revolution is being commemorated on February 22-25 of every year as mandated under Presidential Proclamation No. 1224. All government agencies, civil society organizations, professionals and religious organizations, media and citizenry are enjoined to actively participate in all the commemorative activities as a continuing and permanent source of inspiration for the future generations. The theme of this year's celebration is "Diwa ng EDSA, Gabay sa Ating Kaunlaran".

2. To highlight the celebration, all public and private schools are encouraged to observe the following activities:

- a. conduct of meaningful activities through classroom discussions using Enclosure No. 1, essay writing, debates, and other similar activities; and
- b. recitation of the Ecumenical Prayer (Enclosure No. 2) by the teachers and students during the Flag Raising Ceremony.

3. In this connection, the DepEd National Capital Region (NCR) shall encourage the participation of officials, teachers and students in the following activities:
