## SECOND NATIONAL SCIENCE-MATHEMATICS SUMMIT FOR REGIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOLS (RSHSs)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Regional Science High Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. The Curriculum Development Division Bureau of Secondary Education (CDD-BSE), Department of Education (DepEd) shall conduct the **Second National Science-Mathematics Summit** on March 15 to 19, 2010 inclusive of travel time at the Development Academy of the Philippines, Tagaytay City with the theme: *Culture of Innovations and Best Practices in Science and Mathematics Education.*
- 2. The aim of the activity is to encourage innovations and best practices in enriching teaching and learning strategies in Science and Mathematics. Specifically, it shall enhance the application of knowledge in Science and Mathematics through hands-on learnings, innovative teaching strategies and recent science and mathematics breakthroughs.
- 3. Participants in the Summit shall come from the seventeen (17) Regional Science High Schools (RSHSs). Each school delegation shall consist of one (1) Secondary School Principal, three (3) Science teachers, one (1) Mathematics teacher and four (4) students (one student per year level). Likewise, the Regional and Division Supervisors in Science and Mathematics are strongly encouraged to attend with the aforecited participants following the schedule below:
