- 1. The Art Centre for Children and Young People will hold the 14<sup>th</sup> International Art Exhibition for Children and Young People in Hyvinkaa, Finland which will open in September 2010 with the theme **"My Home"**.
- 2. The Art Centre promotes art education and visual arts locally and globally working in cooperation with experts in the fields of art, culture and youth work. It also organizes exhibitions, collects artworks, educates and encourages to experiences in the world of art.
