FIRST NATIONAL STUDENT GOVERNMENT PROGRAM CONFERENCE

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education–Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED-CSCA), in partnership with the Davao City Federation of Supreme Student Governments, Inc., will conduct the First National Student Government Program Conference on April 7-10, 2010 at The Royal Mandaya Hotel, Davao City.
2. Recognizing the significant role of Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) Advisers, Supreme Student Government (SSG) Advisers, Araling Panlipunan Department Heads, and School Principals and Administrators in reinforcing and enhancing the performance of the SPGs and SSGs and with the theme “Sustaining Initiatives and Expanding Leadership and Management Dimensions”, the conference aims to address the changing demands of the SPG/SSG officers throughout the country and their need for proper guidance by enabling SPG and SSG Advisers and School Principals and Administrators to be more competent, understanding and responsive in handling the Student Government Program (SGP). The conference also seeks to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Discuss and present a national module to establish a comprehensive peer counseling program in schools;
 - b. Conduct consultation and/or follow-up on programs, projects and mechanisms in harnessing the student government as an effective partner in achieving quality education and in responding to the non-academic needs and concerns of students (such as Peer Counseling, Student Representation in the Parents-Teachers Associations, School Governing Council, and others);
 - c. Strengthen the network of SPG and SSG advisers in the country by, among others, organizing them as support organizations to the SPGs and SSGs; and,
 - d. Improve efforts in making available real exposure, experience and learning in responsible and participative democracy and leadership for nationbuilding.
3. Activities during the conference include interactive plenary sessions, break-out sessions, panel discussions, action planning, and division and regional meetings.
4. Participants to this convention are SPG and SSG Advisers, Araling Panlipunan Department Heads, School Principals and Administrators, Regional and Division SPG/SGP Coordinators or Araling Panlipunan Supervisors.



5. Travel of participants shall be on official business. The registration fee for each participant is Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) only chargeable against the school, division, regional funds, MOOE, Local School Board funds or sourced from private organizations or Local Government Units. The registration fee shall cover accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 to breakfast of Day 3, use of venue, lights and sound services, speakers' honoraria, t-shirts, bags, training kits, certificates, transportation, supplies and materials and other incidental and necessary expenses of the convention.

6. Members of the DepED National Organizing Committee and the Secretariat are authorized to travel three (3) days before the start and two (2) days after the conference. The members of the Local DepED Secretariat shall work with the Organizing Committee on official business.

7. Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents and School Principals/Administrators are encouraged to send participants to the First National Student Government Program Conference.

8. The Pre-Registration Form (PRF), Tentative Schedule of Activities, Guidelines, and Members of the DepED Organizing Committee and Secretariat are enclosed as Enclosure Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Arrival of Participants/Registration

Participants are expected to arrive on April 7, 2010. Upon arrival, please proceed to the Registration Area for the verification, payment, billeting assignments and distribution of kits.

Payment

Payment must be in cash.

Billeting and Accommodation
