6<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON TEACHER EDUCATION


1. The University of the Philippines-College of Education will hold the 6<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Teacher Education (ICTED) on July 29-31, 2010 at the SEAMEO INNOTECH, Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City with the theme **"Celebrating Diversity and Transformative Innovations in Teacher Education"**.
2. This conference will serve as a venue for analyzing issues and concerns in training teachers in diverse situations.
3. The theoretical and best practice papers will be presented in the two major conference strands:
  - a. Diversity in Education – papers focusing on the following aspects of diversity: socio economic realities, ethnic or racial differences, language, abilities and disabilities, religion, sexual orientation and gender.
  - b. Transformative Innovations - topics include educative efforts in situations of emergency, crisis and reconstruction, climate change, peace and human rights, educational justice, inclusion, addressing substance abuse, reproductive health, HIV/AIDS, use of information and communication technology, instructional strategies to address diversity, achieving universal participation, completion and total community involvement.
4. The participants to this convention are academics, teacher educators, teacher-practitioners, school administrators, curriculum writers, and policy makers involved in teacher training. They shall attend the conference on **official time only**.
5. A registration fee of Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP6,500.00) will be charged each participant (on-site registration). Discounted rates will be given to early registrants, persons with disabilities, senior citizens and groups of 5 or more (until June 1, 2010). This will cover expenses for snacks, materials, certificates, and other incidental expenses. Participants shall make their own arrangements for lodging/accommodations. Since the venue can accommodate only 300 persons, registration of participants will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
