2011 ASEAN SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE PHILIPPINES

1. The Singapore Government announces the 2011 ASEAN Scholarships for the Philippines. The scholarships are offered to students to pursue 4 years of studies from Secondary 3 to Pre-University 2 in selected Singapore schools, and will lead to the award of the Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE 'A' Level) (or equivalent) Certificate.
2. The ASEAN Scholarships aim to provide opportunities for the young people of ASEAN countries to develop their potentials and equip them with skills that will enable them to confidently step into the new millennium.
3. Applicants must be nationals of the Philippines, born between 1994-1996, have done consistently well in their school examinations and completed at least 2nd year high school at the time of application, maintained a good academic track record and have good records of participation in extra-curricular activities.
