68th COMMEMORATION OF THE ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK

- 1. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 203, s. 1987, declaring April 9 of every year as the Araw ng Kagitingan and the Presidential Proclamation No. 466, s. 1989 declaring the period of April 5-11 of every year as the Philippine Veterans Week, all government agencies including government-owned and controlled corporations, non-government organizations, private associations and institutions, and individuals are enjoined to assist, cooperate, and participate in this historic commemoration. The theme of this year's celebration is "Beterano: Gabay Tungo sa Makabuluhang Pagbabago at Matatag na Republika".
- 2. The commemoration aims to promote, preserve and memorialize the principles, ideals and deeds of the war veterans as a means to enhance patriotism and love of country, especially among the youth.
- 3. This Department, being a member of the Multi-Agency Task Force (MATF) encourages all DepEd regional, division and school officials to attend and participate in all the activities lined-up for this year's celebration.
- 4. To highlight the commemoration, the Department of Education (DepEd) in coordination with the Department of National Defense (DND) through the MATF will conduct the following activities:
 - a. **Guhit ng Kabayanihan at Kagitingan** This is an on-the-spot poster making contest open for Grades V and VI pupils enrolled in public and private elementary schools within the National Capital Region (NCR). Each division is entitled to five (5) entries to the competition which will be held on March 27, 2010 at the Libingan ng mga Bayani, Taguig City. Please refer to Enclosure No. 1 for Program of Activities and DepEd Participation and Enclosure No. 2 for Poster-Making Contest Guidelines;
 - b. **2**nd **National Creative Painting Competition** This is open to high school students enrolled in public and private secondary schools nationwide. Deadline for the submission of entries is on



March 29, 2010. Please refer to Enclosure No. 3 for the Creative Painting Contest Guidelines; and

- c. *First National Essay Writing Competition* This is open to all high school students nationwide. Deadline for the submission of entries is on March 29, 2010. Please refer to Enclosure No. 4 for the Essay Writing Competition Mechanics.
- 5. Travel expenses (transportation and per diem) of the winners and coaches or teacher chaperones shall be charged to local funds while board and lodging of the winners and their coaches or chaperons, cash prizes, medals, and trophies shall be charged to the MATF funds. Expenses for the supplies and materials, meals and snacks, documentation and communication, TEVs and honoraria of the judges and Task Force, and other miscellaneous and operational expenses shall charged to OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CONTEST MECHANICS GUHIT NG KABAYANIHAN AT KAGITINGAN

(On-The-Spot Poster Making Contest)

- 1. The contest is open to Grade V and VI pupils enrolled in any public or private elementary schools within the National Capital Region.
- 2. Each Division is entitled to five (5) entries to the competition. Each contestant shall be accompanied by their coach or chaperone during the competition. It will be held at the Libingan Ng Mga Bayani, Taguig City on March 27, 2010. Registration shall begin at 5:00 am and the contest will commence at 7:00 o'clock in the morning.
- 3. The contest aims to show the valor and victory of our World War II heroes and veterans through depicting the theme of the celebration.
- 4. From the eighty (80) elementary pupil participants, five (5) will be adjudged winners (1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place, and 2 Runner-Ups).
- 5. The Criteria for Judging are as follows:

a.	Originality		40%
b.	Visual Impact		30%
c.	Message/Relevanc	e to the theme	30%

- 6. The DepED-Secretariat (TWC) shall assign a number to each entry at the start of the contest. The number shall be the basis for identification of winners and names shall be revealed only after the judging.
- 7. The contestants with their advisers or coach or chaperone will bring their drawing paraphernalia. Drawing canvass or cartolina shall be provided by the managing committee.
- 8. The contest shall be managed by the DepED Special Events Unit and sponsored by the Department of National Defense (DND), the lead agency of the celebration. Expenses incurred in the conduct of the contest such as prizes,, trophies for the school, medals for the winners, and meals during the contest shall be charged to MATF funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

CONTEST MECHANICS 2ND NATIONAL CREATIVE PAINTING CONTEST

- 1. The contest is open to all high students (1st to 4th year) enrolled in any public or private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.
- 2. The theme of the competition is "Beterano: Gabay Tungo sa Makabuluhang Pagbabago at Matatag na Republika". It aims to increase awareness of the Araw Ng Kagitingan as a shining moment of courage and commitment to freedom by our WWII veterans.
- 3. It should be in a 20" x 30" illustration board. A message must be type-written (Filipino or English) and placed at the back of the painting.
- 4. Criteria are as follows:

a. Originality 40%b. Visual Impact 30%c. Message 30%Total 100%

- 5. All entries must be submitted not later than March 29, 2010. It must be accompanied by the following requirements:
 - a. A certification from the principal that the contestant is enrolled in the current school year (SY 2009-2010);
 - b. Scanned image of the student and the principals' school ID or any valid ID; and
 - c. The accomplished entry form.
