2010 NATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR SCIENCE EDUCATORS


1. The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), in cooperation with the Department of Education–Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED–CSCA), Department of Science and Technology–Science Education Institute (DOST–SEI) and ABS-CBN-DZMM will conduct the 2010 National Conference for Science Educators on April 23-27, 2010 at the Almont Inland Resort, Butuan City.
2. With the theme “Science Research Towards Development”, the conference aims to provide opportunities for the participants to:
  - a. share new trends and best practices in science research;
  - b. discuss various programs and projects related to research and development;
  - c. share science teaching strategies that promote maximum potential among youth;
  - d. develop programs and projects for science research; and
  - e. strengthen partnership among science stakeholders on the institutionalization of science research nationwide.
3. Activities during the conference include plenary sessions, group dynamics, project studies, presentations and workshops.
4. Participants to the conference are Science Teachers, Science Club Advisers, Master Teachers, Head Teachers, Department Heads, School Principals, District Supervisors, Division and Regional Supervisors in Science and Science Enthusiasts from the different public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide.
5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP5,200.00) shall be charged each participant to cover accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 to dinner of Day 3, training kits, certificates, speakers’ honoraria, t-shirt and other incidental expenses of the program chargeable against local funds, local school board funds and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents and School Heads/Principals are encouraged to send participants to the conference. The Regional Supervisors in-charge of the programs and projects in Science shall undertake the coordination in the field offices pertaining to their delegation and representation during the conference.



7. Members of the National Organizing Committee are allowed to travel two (2) days before the start and one (1) day after the conference. The Tentative Program of Activities is enclosed.
