

THE PHILIPPINE FOUNDATION FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (PFST)
PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS

- 1. The Philippine Foundation for Science and Technology (PFST) has designed programs and projects to promote science and technology consciousness among the youth and various sectors of society.
- 2. The programs/projects are the following:
 - a. **Philippine Science Centrum (PSC)** is an alternative learning center that unfolds new exciting process of science-learning system through the use of integrative and interactive exhibits. Located at E-Com Building, Riverbanks Center, Barangka, Marikina City, the PSC is open from Mondays to Saturdays, 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - b. Adventures in Discovery (AID) Traveling Science Centrum, Sci-Fun Caravan, Science on the Move and Science Works! are traveling science exhibitions featuring replicas of PSC's popular interactive exhibits which primarily aims to reach the various individuals, communities, academic institutions and organizations in the countryside;
 - c. **Teachers Science Camp** is a 3-day (live-in or live-out) seminar workshop on "Teaching Science Through Interactive and Integrative Approaches", designed for science teachers. It aims to complement the formal education system by introducing the interactive learning as well as integrative approaches in the science curriculum;
 - d. Philippine Science Centrum Search for Exhibits from the Youth (PSCSEXY) is an activity directed towards developing the students' ability on observation, research, analysis and practical application via project-prototypes focusing on science-related subjects and phenomena. This project is designed for 3rd and 4th year high school students from S&T oriented and science high schools (public and private) of the National Capital Region (NCR);
 - e. **Science Centrum Fabrication, Inc. (SCFI)** is the exhibit fabrication unit of PFST for interactive exhibits with technical capability of developing, prototyping, fabricating and/or manufacturing interactive exhibits and other paraphernalia for the promotion and development of science and technology.



- 3. As these projects are jointly implemented with DepEd to foster consciousness and advocate public understanding of science and technology, DepEd regional and division officials, teachers and students are encouraged to include the Philippine Science Centrum, Adventures in Discover-Traveling Science Centrum, Sci-Fun Caravan, Science on the Move and Science Works! as venues for educational field trips.
