1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Education Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO-INNOTECH) will conduct the 2010 Scholarship Program entitled "District Supervisors Leadership (DSL) Program".

2. The training program will address the requirement of the Department for leadership capability building interventions of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) in order to build and enhance their competencies to lead efforts in transforming schools and learning centers in the district toward improved learning outcomes of children and youth.

3. Participants to this program are PSDSs who are sixty (60) years old and below. The PSDSs who have participated in previous AIM/DepED eXCELS I and II/PHRDF training programs are not eligible to attend this particular program.

4. The program will be conducted in three phases. Phase 1 is a two-week face-to-face live-in training at SEAMEO INNOTECH. Phase 2 is a two-week online session for learning exchange and mentoring. Phase 3 is a one-week online session for progress monitoring. There will be a one-day Revalida cum Integration session for all participants who would have successfully completed all the requirements of this program.

5. For Phase 1 which is the two-week face-to-face live-in training, there shall be organized sixteen (16) classes of thirty-one (31) DepEd scholars per class assembled by regions. For Phases 2 and 3 which are the online sessions, there shall be organized classes of 15 or 16 participants with one assigned learning mentor per class. Enclosed is the schedule of classes for Phases 1, 2, and 3.

6. The SEAMEO INNOTECH shall provide each participant one (1) laptop computer as a major learning tool for the duration of the Phase 1 sessions with free internet connectivity within campus. Each participant shall also receive a memory stick (flash disk) to store the reference materials and outputs generated in class for use in Phases 1 and 2 of the program. During Phases 2 and 3 the participants will



need to access the internet from local providers. The SEAMEO INNOTECH shall reimburse a maximum of Three Hundred Pesos (PhP300.00) per participant for internet charges actually incurred during the sessions of Phases 2 and 3. Receipts will be accepted for refund at the scheduled Revalida cum Integration session.

7. All Regional Directors are hereby requested to identify/nominate participants who will attend this program based on the qualifications. Deadline of submission shall be **on or before April 15**. A separate DepEd Memorandum shall be issued to announce the Scholars of the SEAMEO INNOTECH "District Supervisors Leadership (DSL) Program" for 2010. See enclosure for the indicative schedules of this Program.

8. Tuition fee (which includes hotel accommodation and meals for the two-week live-in training at SEAMEO INNOTECH) will be paid individually by each DepEd scholar and charged to DepEd. Transportation to and from their station to the training venue and other allowable expenses will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
