MODEL OF EXCELLENCE SCHOOLS SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 50, s. 2004 on the Implementing Guidelines on the Model of Excellence (MOE) Schools Program, a two (2)-day summer training program will be conducted by the Books for the Barrios, Inc. Enclosed is the schedule of the training program per division.
- 2. The objectives of the program are to:
 - equip teachers with necessary knowledge and skills in implementing teaching-learning disciplines of the Model of Excellence Schools program;
 - b. enable them to be more innovative and interdisciplinary in their instructional activities; and
 - c. train teachers and school principals to develop their competence and skills using the Model of Excellence Schools for academic enhancement programs, and proper utilization of instructional materials.
- 3. Activities during the training will include lectures, simulations, hands-on teachings and other interactive exercises.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover food and accommodation. Travel expenses of the participants will be charged against local funds, subject to its availability, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. As counterpart, Books for the Barrios, Inc. will shoulder the 50% of the registration fee of each participant.
- 5. In line with this, all concerned regional, division and school officials are requested to assist and support the Books for the Barrios Training Team during its visit to their respective jurisdictions.
