1. The Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC), Ministry of Education, Thailand, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd), announces the 2010 Rajamangala University of Technology Rattanakosin (RMUTR) Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students in ASEAN Countries.
2. The objective of the program is to respond to the call for educational cooperation among ASEAN countries for a harmonious relationship and also to further establish cooperation in other aspects. This involves the offering of a four (4) to five (5) year scholarship to high school students who shall qualify based on the standards set by the RMUTR.
3. All DepEd regional offices are directed to open the program for application to all interested graduating high school students this School Year 2009-2010. Applicants should submit the accomplished application forms and the required documents to RMUTR by April 30, 2010.
4. The names of the successful candidates will be announced by the RMUTR by May 15, 2010.
5. The implementing guidelines for the Scholarship Program, list of bachelor's degree fields of study and the application form are enclosed.

## **Year 2010 RMUTR Scholarship Program for Undergraduate Students in ASEAN Countries**

As the era of ASEAN community is approaching, Rajamangala University of Technology Rattanakosin (RMUTR) realizes the importance of educational cooperation among ASEAN countries for more friendly relationship and for further establishing cooperation in other aspects. Thus, RMUTR is pleased to offer scholarships to high school students in ASEAN countries for their study in the bachelor's degree level in various fields of study provided by RMUTR in Academic Year 2010.

The terms and conditions of the scholarships are as follows:

1. The RMUTR Scholarship Program is open to all ASEAN candidates.
2. The scholarships do not carry a bond.
3. The scholarships cover only tuitions fees, without including any other costs, nor guaranteeing employment or residence in Thailand to the scholars upon their graduation.
4. The scholarship covers the entire duration of the undergraduate program (4 years/5years) provided that every year the scholar demonstrates satisfactory progress as determined by RMUTR.
5. Applicants' Qualifications:
  - Both applicants and their parents must possess the citizenship of a foreign country. (Applicants and their parents should not hold the Thai citizenship.)
  - Applicants should have adequate health, both mentally and physically to stay in a foreign country for a long period of time.
  - Persons who can contribute to promoting the mutual friendship between Thailand and the country of origin.
  - Applicants should be under 25 years of age as of March 1, 2010.
  - Applicants must hold high school certificates as of March 1, 2010.
  - Applications should obtain a grade point average (G.P.A.) of above 85% or 5% in rank from the top, from the last institution attended.
  - Proficiency in Thai will be highly preferred. The medium of instruction in undergraduate programs provided by RMUTR is Thai. So, the candidates for the scholarships should be able to use the Thai language at least in the fair level.
6. Scholarship Payment
  - Scholarship Period: 4 years/5 years of a bachelor's degree program.
7. Procedure for Scholarship Award
  - Applicants should submit the application forms and the required documents to RMUTR by 30 April, 2010.
  - The name list of the successful candidates will be announced by RMUTR by 15 May, 2010.
8. Documents to be submitted
  - One application form
  - Two 4cm x 5cm color photos
  - Two recommendation letters
  - One personal medical assessment
  - One copy of high school certificate
  - One transcript from high school
  - Certificates of the foreign citizenship of the applicant and his/her parents (copies of passports and such)

- Documents that prove the relationship between the applicant and his/her parents (copies of a family register and such)
  - Certificates of TOEFL or IELTS (only applicable to those who have it)
  - One certificate of health authorized by a doctor (only for the final candidates selected by RMUTR)
9. All applicants must complete the prescribed application forms (available on website: <http://inter.rmutr.ac.th>).
10. Note:
- Application forms and other program materials are to be filled out either in Thai or in English.
  - Submitted documents to RMUTR will not be returned to the applicant.
  - Incomplete or invalid documents are subject to rejection by RMUTR.
11. Application Deadline: 30 April 2010.

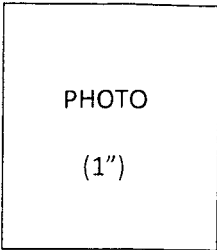
