## 53RD NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION

- 1. The 53<sup>rd</sup> National Conference of Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education (NCCACEE) will be held on May 23-27, 2010 at the Pearlmont Inn, Limketkai Drive, Cagayan de Oro City.
- 2. The conference will focus on the theme "Policy Review and Directions Toward Improved Elementary Education Performance".
- 3. The conference aims to:
  - a. review existing elementary education policies and provide recommendations;
  - b. set targets for meeting performance indicators in the elementary education sector; and
  - c. conceptualize new programs and projects to ensure achievement of EFA and MDG by 2015.
- 3. The participants to this conference are the 34 Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary Education Division in the regions and the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) Director, Assistant Director and selected Education Program Specialists from BEE. Please see Enclosure Nos. 1 for the list of participants, and 2, for the program of activities.
- 4. Participants are required to bring their data on actual performance indicators for SY 2008-2009, 2009-2010; achievement rate-MPS in different learning areas, cohort, survival rate, completion rate, enrolment rate, dropout rate, etc. Likewise, they are requested to bring their data on target performance indicators for SY 2010-2015 and data on the number and name of schools with computer per division in the region.
- 5. Attendance to this activity shall be on official business. A registration fee of Seven Thousand Pesos (PhP7,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials, resource persons' fee and other related expenses. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
