COMPUTATION OF PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY FOR TEACHERS  
 SCHOOL YEAR 2009-2010

To: Regional Directors  
 Schools Division/City Superintendents  
 Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools  
 All Others Concerned

1. This is to provide the field offices with a uniform basis in the computation of the **Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP)** under the teacher/s leave basis that an elementary/secondary teacher is entitled to.

2. Teachers who rendered continuous services for School Year 2009-2010 from June 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010, shall be entitled to 74 days PVP from April 1 to June 13, 2010, computed as follows:

Total no. of days served = 304 days  
 June 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010

Less: Christmas vacation days = -16 days  
 (December 19, 2009 to January 3, 2010)

Actual days served = 288 days  
 Multiply factor x 0.312

Total PVP including Christmas vacation days = 90 days

Less: Christmas vacation = -16 days

PVP earned from April 1 to June 13, 2010 = 74 days

Derivation of factor 0.312

No. of summer vacation days = 74 days  
 (April 1 to June 13, 2010)

Add: No. of Christmas vacation days = +16 days

Total PVP and Christmas vacation = 90 days

Divided by actual days served = 288

Factor = **0.312**

3. Factor 0.312 shall be used for the computation of absences and PVP this school year.
