

GRANT OF STEP INCREMENT FOR TEACHERS WITH SPECIALIZATION IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

To: DepEd ARMM Regional Secretary

- 1. One of the salient features which was approved under the Salary Standardization Law III (SSL III) is the provision of a three-step increment for teachers with specialization in Science and Mathematics. This provision is in line with the thrust of giving focus to teaching Science and Mathematics in basic education to set the foundation for critical tooling towards industrialization and improvement of the country's global competitiveness standing.
- 2. This grant of step increment covers incumbents of Teacher I, Teacher II and Teacher III positions in public elementary and secondary schools who teach Science and/or Mathematics.
- 3. The incentive shall be in the form of a one-time three (3) salary step increment to a teacher who meets **ALL** of the following criteria for qualification:

- 4. The initial grant of step increment shall start on January 1, 2011. The next grant for new qualifiers shall be January 1 of every year thereafter.
- 5. The actual monthly basic salary of an incumbent teacher as of December 31 of the prior year shall be adjusted to the next three (3) salary steps, effective January 1 of the next year, but not beyond Step 8. For example, if an incumbent of a position of Teacher I, SG 11 has a basic monthly salary at Step 1, his/her monthly basic salary shall be adjusted to that at Step 4.
- 6. In order to determine the budgetary requirements for the step increment, all field offices are required to accomplish and submit the enclosed data gathering forms as follows:
 - a) Form A (Elementary) and Form A (Secondary) to be accomplished by the school head which contains the names of teachers who meet ALL the criteria listed in Par. 3 above;
 - b) Form B (Elementary) and Form B (Secondary) to be accomplished by the Division Superintendent which summarizes the number of qualified teachers in each school by position title and step increment; and
 - c) Form C (Elementary) and Form C (Secondary) to be accomplished by the Regional Director which summarizes the number of qualified teachers in each Division by position title and step increment.
- 7. School heads shall be responsible for verifying the accuracy of data entered in Form A by requiring the concerned teachers to submit documentary evidence e.g. certified true copies of transcript of records, certificates of training and performance ratings. These documents should be kept on file at the school and Division Office and need not be submitted to the Central Office.
- 8. The Department of Budget and Management (DBM) shall issue guidelines governing the implementation of step increment.
- 9. The duly accomplished Forms (A, B, and C) shall be forwarded by the Regional Offices to the Management Division, Central Office (Attn: Ms. Louisa Roberto) on or before May 31, 2010. No piece meal submission shall be accepted, i.e. individual schools or individual divisions. Submission of individual schools or divisions shall not be included in the national summary to be prepared by the Management Division.

- These guidelines supersede the previous Unnumbered Memorandum signed by Undersecretary Ramon C. Bacani dated July 22, 2009 on this subject.
- 11. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
