DepEd MEMORANDUM No. **212**, s. 2010

LEADERSHIP TRAINING SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICERS OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS (PAESPA) AND REGIONAL PRESIDENTS OF THE ELEMENTARY SPA ASSOCIATIONS (RAESPA)

Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. Republic Act No. 7079 or the Campus Journalism Act of 1991 provides among others that "seminars and workshops may be conducted in coordination with the national association of school paper advisers". In view of this, a Leadership Training Seminar-Workshop for Executive Officers of the Philippine Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (PAESPA) and Regional Presidents of the Elementary SPA Associations (RAESPA) will be held at Ecotech, Lahug, Cebu City on May 24-27, 2010.
- 2. The seminar-workshop aims to:
 - provide a forum for sharing ideas among participants coming from different geographical locations in proposing projects for the improvement of the journalism program in the elementary grades;
 - b. identify and address issues or concerns regarding contest mechanics and conduct of trainings;
 - c. prepare a syllabus in journalism for the elementary grades;
 - d. edit and finalize the compilation of the Outstanding School Paper Adviser Awardees of each region from year 2000 to year 2009; and
 - e. enhance the leadership qualities of the current officers and regional presidents by instilling in them awareness of the journalism program.
- 3. The participants (list enclosed) to this activity are as follows:
 - a. nine (9) executive officers of the PAESPA representing their respective regions;
 - b. one former executive officer who has served PAESPA for the last fifteen (15) years; and
 - c. ten (10) incumbent presidents of the Regional Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (RAESPA) whose regions are not represented by the executive officers.



- 4. The incumbent RAESPA President may nominate one (1) regional association officer to attend, however, transportation, board and lodging expenses shall be charged against their regional and division association funds, local journalism funds or local school board subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Other incumbent RAESPA Presidents whose regions are already represented by the national executive officers (Regions III, IV-A, VI, VIII, Caraga, ARMM and NCR), may also attend or nominate one (1) among their regional executive officers, provided that all traveling, board and lodging expenses shall be charged against their regional and division association funds, local school funds or local school board, subject to availability, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against their respective regional and division association funds, local journalism funds or local school board, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations while board, lodging and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the available funds of the PAESPA.
- 7. Transportation expenses of the resource person/monitor from CDD-BEE shall be charged against the Campus Journalism Funds as provided for in the Campus Journalism Act of 1991 or R.A. No. 7079 subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. All participants by divisions must confirm their attendance one (1) week before the seminar-workshop to Ms. Henrietta V.
