





1. The Associated Schools Project Network (ASPnet) of the UNESCO National Commission (NatCom) of the Philippines will hold a National Campus Media Workshop with the theme, "School Paper Advisers as Agents of UNESCO ASPnet Ideals" on May 27-28, 2010 at the University of Makati, Makati City.
2. This capacity-building workshop for secondary school campus media advisers aims to enable the participants to:
