PHILIPPINE HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION (PHEA) NATIONAL ANNUAL CONVENTION AND SEARCH FOR THE PHILIPPINES' BEST NEEDLECRAFT TEACHER OF 2010

- 1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd) will hold its Annual Convention with the theme "New Century for Home Economics: New Challenges, New Solutions" on October 22-24, 2010 at the Dynasty Court Hotel, Tiano corner Hayes Sts., Cagayan de Oro City.
- 2. The objectives of the convention are to:
  - a. equip *Edukasyong Pantahan at Pangkalusugan* (EPP)/
    Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) teachers with the right understanding of the 2010 Secondary Education Curriculum (SEC);
  - b. conduct the annual search for the Philippines' Best Needlecraft Teacher of 2010; and
  - c. address the challenges in education, environment and family ties through consultation with the members of PHEA.
- 3. The participants to these activities are regional and division supervisors, school heads/principals, department heads/chairmen, coordinators, TLE and EPP teachers from public and private schools, DepEd scholars from each region, PHEA regional coordinators and regional contestants for the Search for Best Needlecraft Teacher. Attendance in this convention shall be **on official time**.
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP4,700.00) shall be charged each participant and inclusive of hotel accommodations, food, seminar kits, certificates, honorarium for speakers and city tours.

#### GUIDELINES FOR SEARCH FOR THE PHILIPPINES BEST NEEDLECRAFT TEACHERS 2010

- 1. To continue the commitment of Philippine Home Economics Association and DMC-Focus Global Inc partnership in upgrading PHEA member teachers skills and proficiency in Needlecraft, as well as to give recognition, a Needlecraft Demonstration contest entitled "SEARCH FOR THE PHILIPPINES BEST NEEDLECRAFT TEACHERS 2010" will be held to be participated by regional representatives who will be official delegates to the convention.
- 1.1. To stimulate creativity and originality among EPP teachers by giving them the liberty to create and demonstrate their own method on how to teach needlecraft and design their own DMC Product.
- 1.2. To communicate that cross stitching is not only limited for framing/display purposes, but for various creative applications as well.
- 1.3. To provide incentive for teachers to push cross-stitch as projects for students and recognize their efforts in teaching needlecraft.
- 1.4. Previous winners in PHEA needlecraft conventions are not allowed to participate
- 1.5. General Guidelines
- a. All EPP teachers are welcome to join
- b. There should only be 1 representative per region chosen by their school divisions provided that he/she is an official delegate to the PHEA 2010 Convention.
- c. Contestants must create their own methodology in teaching needlecraft and be able to demonstrate it during the PHEA Convention in front of the judges and selected group of teachers as audience.
- d. Needlecraft content should include CROSS STITCH and other basic stitches with the use of DMC Threads.
- e. The 15-minute needlecraft demo will include methodology and demonstration on how to do a simple DMC Product.
- f. Contestants shall provide/prepare their own materials because they have to demonstrate step by step instructions on how to do the DMC item and show a finished product.
- g. The needlecraft skills can be done in various creative applications such as: Bags, Home Items, School Items, Clothing and others.
- h. Contestants can use any material and other stitches for their DMC item IN ADDITION to the use of DMC Threads, Aida Cloth and Cross stitches.
- i. Cross stitch designs can be an original or any existing DMC pattern.

j. Actual demonstration, judging and awarding of winners will be done during the PHEA 2010 Convention in Cagayan de Oro City on October 2010.

### 1.6. Criteria for judging for the Needlecraft Demo contest among contestants

a. Methodology	70%
i. Skills (proper way of stitching, ability to explain we	30%
ii. Content (cross stitch, basic stitches, trivia, organizat	tion) 30%
iii. Uniqueness (method of demonstration, visuals)	10%
b. DMC Item	30%
i. Application (originality, practicality)	15%
ii. Creativity (cross stitch design, innovative)	15%
