- The Philippine Association of Nutrition, Inc. (PAN) will hold its 63rd Annual Convention with the theme "Safeguarding Nutrition of Infants and Young Children". This will be held at the EDSA Shangrila Hotel, 1 Garden Way, Ortigas Center, Mandaluyong City on July 8-9, 2010.
- 2. The convention aims to:
  - help participants appreciate the appropriate and optimal nutrition for infants and young children and the resources that are available to them to help them in their tasks; and
