CONDUCT OF THE 2ND QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL

- 1. Pursuant to Memorandum Directive No. 10, s. 2010 of the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC) dated May 17, 2010, the 2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill will be conducted on June 18, 2010 at 8:00 a.m. The said Memorandum Directive also stated the instructions from the NDCC Chairman on the expanded and continuing conduct of the quarterly nationwide simultaneous earthquake drills as directed by the President of the Philippines since 2006.
- 2. This activity will adopt the theme "One Nation, One People, One Response" of the Table Top Exercise on Earthquake Drill at the National Capital Region (TX-NCR-EQ-DR) which was held last April 16, 2010. During the activity, the need for regular exercises with focus on schools, commercial establishments, hospitals and government facilities including military/police camps were identified.
- 3. For this quarter's earthquake drill, the Benigno Aquino National High School in Makati City will be the venue of the ceremonial pressing of the button to start the drill, wherein the Secretaries of Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Department of National Defense, and Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) are expected to attend. After the ceremonial pressing of the button, the Ortigas Center Association, Inc. in Pasig City followed by the East Avenue Medical Center and Camp General Emilio Aguinaldo, both in Quezon City, will be showcasing the capabilities of local responders on actions like building evacuation, Incident Command System, triage of mass casualties, collapsed structure, search and rescue, fire suppression and PAF helicopter hoist/rescue.
- 4. In view of this, all public and private schools are encouraged to join the conduct of the said drill to demonstrate their capabilities and preparedness and inculcate in the minds of the school children the proper responses before, during and after an earthquake.
